

Student Financial Aid and Bursary Opportunities

[AMI Robert Pearson Memorial](#)

The scholarship program is open to Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada with a permanent disability who are currently registered in and returning to a full-time program of study at an accredited Canadian post-secondary college or university. AMI will award two **\$5,000 bursaries** to two deserving students with a permanent disability: one from the English community and one from the French.

[Association des Collèges et Universités de la Francophonie Canadienne \(ACUFC\)](#)

English-speaking Canadians enrolled in the first year of a college or university program have an opportunity to receive a **\$3,000 bursary** to perfect their bilingualism while studying in a field of interest.

[Association Québécoise du Codéveloppement professionnel \(AQCP\)](#)

Every year, the AQCP is proud to support a student in a research project on the foundations or the practice of the co-development group according to the *Payette and Champagne method*. Eligible projects may relate to aspects relating to effectiveness criteria, impacts, facilitation, support, facilitation, learning processes, evaluation of learning achieved, etc. or on one of the stages of the professional co-development process. **Bursary amount \$3,000.**

[Bourses de soutien à la persévérance et à la réussite des stagiaires](#)

Scholarships for trainees are granted for the last compulsory traineeship in certain training courses related to the fields of education or health and social services. **Bursary amount from \$900 to \$4000.**

[Bourses Parcours pour la mobilité étudiante](#)

This scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to students who choose to study in a CEGEP far from their home. An annual scholarship of **\$7,500** per student, for the normal duration of the study program, is paid to eligible students.

[Canada Graduate Scholarships \(CGS M\) program](#)

The objective of the Canada Graduate Scholarships (CGS M) program is to contribute to the development of research skills and the training of highly qualified personnel by supporting students who are achieving high achievement in their undergraduate and graduate studies. The CGS M program provides financial support to high-calibre students who are enrolled in an eligible Canadian program of study at the master's level or, in some cases, at the doctoral level. **Bursary amount \$17 500.**

[Canadian Medical Hall of Fame](#)

The Canadian Medical Hall of Fame Award recognizes medical students who demonstrate qualities such as perseverance, collaboration and entrepreneurial spirit and show outstanding potential as future leaders and innovators of health care in Canada. Each Canadian medical school is invited to nominate one (1) medical student, completing his/her second undergraduate year of study at the time of application. Laureates of the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame will receive an award with a **cash value of \$5000** and a complimentary ticket and travel subsidy for the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony.

[Canadian Nurses Fondation/ Fondation des infirmières et infirmiers du Canada](#)

The Canadian Nurses Foundation provides scholarships for nursing students across Canada at the baccalaureate, masters and Ph.D. levels. These scholarships are awarded based on merit and range from **\$750 to \$10,000**.

[Citadel Foundation](#)

The Citadel Foundation offers a variety of bursaries to young individuals from the Quebec City region seeking to pursue higher education at the post-secondary level. Since its inception, Citadel Foundation has disbursed over 1.1 million dollars to needy students, helping them attain their educational dreams.

Bursary amounts from \$1,200 to \$8000.

[CMA Foundation/Fondation AMC](#)

The CMA Foundation is providing annual funding to support medical students in Canada. This program celebrates the values of the profession while providing financial support for medical students who need it most. The awards recognize student leaders who demonstrate the values of professionalism, including honesty, integrity, respect, responsibility, accountability, collaboration and a commitment to self-improvement. **Bursary amounts from \$8,500 to \$20,000.**

[CRSSS de la Baie-James](#)

The national scholarship is offered to students who are in one of the last two years of their final program. In partnership with the Ministry of Health and Social Services, the CRSSS de la Baie-James pays the student an amount of **\$15,000 for each year**, in two installments of \$7,500, paid in September and January. The scholarship can therefore **total \$30,000** and the student must commit to working full-time for three years (36 months) in his field of training.

[Fondation de l'Ordres des infirmières et infirmiers du Québec \(OIIQ\)](#)

The mission of the Foundation of the Order of Nurses of Quebec is to encourage studies in nursing sciences as well as the professional development of nurses in Quebec, by offering financial support to facilitate the acquisition of in-depth skills in nursing science. It thus intends to promote recognition of the determining role of the profession within the Quebec health system.

The annual **undergraduate scholarship** program includes 23 regional scholarships of **\$7,000** for OIIQ members who begin their undergraduate university studies in the fall.

The Noëllette-Drouin scholarship provides two provincial scholarships worth **\$10,000** each to graduating students in the undergraduate university nursing program.

The annual **graduate scholarship** program includes four provincial scholarships of **\$10,000** intended for members of the OIIQ who are pursuing their graduate university training in the fall in nursing sciences or in one of the related fields deemed relevant during analysis by the selection committee.

[La Fondation Émergence lance la Bourse d'excellence Laurent-McCutcheon](#)

The Laurent-McCutcheon Scholarship is an excellence scholarship for master's students whose research topic is the realities of people of sexual diversity and the plurality of gender identities and expressions (LGBTQ2+). Fondation Émergence is pleased to offer the Laurent-McCutcheon Scholarship each year, in the amount of **\$4,000**.

[Lea Roback Foundation](#)

The Lea Roback Foundation seeks to promote education as a means for the self-realization and emancipation of everyone and to financially support women who wish to further their education.

General scholarships range from **\$1,000 to \$3,500**; while the Madeleine-Parent and Hélène-Pedneault scholarships are **\$2,000** each, and at times, the latter can be awarded in conjunction with a general scholarship. In addition, five or six Pierre-Laurier-Baribeau scholarships and Fondation de la JOC scholarships are offered.

[Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur \(MES\)](#)

In order to promote the training of new professors in nursing sciences, scholarships are awarded by the Ministry of Higher Education (MES), in partnership with the nine Quebec universities that offer training in nursing sciences (Laval University, McGill University, University of Montreal, University of Sherbrooke, UQAC, UQAR, UQAT, UQTR and UQO). Two types of scholarships (Masters and Doctoral) are awarded on a competitive basis. **Bursary amounts from \$20,000 to \$39,000.**

[Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux \(MSSS\)](#)

The purpose of the scholarship programs of the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (MSSS) is to support institutions in the health and social services network in attracting and retaining workers in certain job titles. Scholarships are offered in the following areas: clinical biochemistry; advanced drug therapy; medical physics; midwifery practice for some regions; psychotherapy; nursing care for specialized nurse practitioners; Assistance to persons in institutions and at home (beneficiary attendants and health and social services auxiliaries). Scholarships are also available in areas identified as vulnerable as part of the network's annual workforce planning exercise. These scholarships are offered to students interested in filling a hard-to-fill position in a remote area. **Bursary amounts from \$10,000 to \$90,000.**

[Montreal Lakeshore University Women's Club](#)

The Montreal Lakeshore University Women's Club is offering two **\$2,000** scholarships to female university students.

[Ordre des travailleurs sociaux et des thérapeutes conjugaux et familiaux du Québec \(OTSTCFQ\)](#)

The Order annually recognizes the excellence of its members and students in social work and marriage and family therapy. It awards three scholarships to undergraduate, master's and doctoral students in partnership with La Personnelle. **Bursary amounts from \$750 to \$5,000.**

[Québec Perspective Scholarships](#)

Scholarships offered to college and university students who have successfully completed a full-time study term according to the eligibility requirements, in a targeted program of study. **Bursary amounts from \$1,500 to \$2,500.**

[Soroptimist Foundation of Canada](#)

The Soroptimist Foundation of Canada annually offers several **\$8,500** grants to female graduate students in Canada who are pursuing careers that focus on improving the quality of women's lives. Examples of such careers include, but are not limited to providing medical services, providing legal counselling and assistance, counselling mature women entering or re-entering the labour market, counselling women in crisis, counselling and training women for non-traditional employment, and positions in women's centres.

[Speech-Language & Audiology Canada \(SAC\)](#)

SAC recognizes that students are a vital part of their membership and the future of the professions they represent. They offer a variety of scholarships with amounts from **\$750 to \$2500.**

[South Shore University Women's Club](#)

The South Shore University Women's Club offers awards to female university students. Interested individuals do not apply to the Club but to the institution they are attending. **Bursary amounts from \$500 to \$1,000.**

[Université de Montréal](#)

The University of Montreal offers scholarships to encourage future graduates of certain courses in the fields of education, health and social services to persevere and succeed in their studies. **Bursary amounts from \$2,500 to \$4,000.**

[Université du Québec à Chicoutimi \(UQAC\)](#)

The Involvement Scholarships- FUQAC are offered to students of all levels of study who are distinguished by their outstanding volunteer involvement in academia or the community. Whether community (volunteering, mentoring, involvement with youth, participation in a board of directors) or academic (organization of events, participation in interuniversity competitions, involvement in the program association, etc.) **Bursary amounts from \$1,000 to \$2,500.**

[Université du Québec à Rimouski \(UQAR\)- Bourse Rolande-Pelletier](#)

As part of the fundraising campaigns of the Fondation de l'Université du Québec à Rimouski, contributions have been made by various departments and organizations for the creation of a capitalized scholarship fund that awards scholarships annually to recognize merit and encourage students pursuing graduate studies in the field of nursing and social work studies at UQAR - Rimouski campus. **Bursary amounts \$1,000 to \$1,500.**
