

Eligibility Requirements

The Bursary Program is open to full-time students from Quebec Regions who :

- are Canadian citizens or permanent residents
- have resided in their home region for at least 2 years
- are pursuing studies in a government recognized educational institution located INSIDE or OUTSIDE their home region
- are currently accepted into or pursuing full-time studies in a government recognized health and social services program that permits the student to work professionally in Quebec upon completion of studies; this program of study must prepare them for careers where they will be providing direct care and services.
- are registered full-time during the Academic Year
- have the appropriate English and French language skills to provide health and social services in a health and social services institution in Quebec
- agree to participate in any follow-up, monitoring or evaluation of the Program conducted by Dialogue McGill and / or the community network

Return-for-Service

Students selected by MEPEC will be required, following completion of their studies, to work in the Montérégie East region in a public Health and Social Services institution for a minimum of one year per bursary awarded.

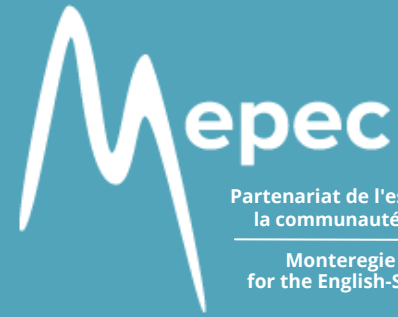
